

Asymmetric One-button Scarf (a one ball project)

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MATERIALS:

One 100 yard ball aran weight alpaca or cashmere yarn
US 8 (5mm) needles
One special 1.5 to 2" button

CAST ON 25 sts by cable cast-on method to conserve yarn. Work in seed stitch for 30 rows. BUTTONHOLE ROW: Seed 11 sts, starting with that 11th st BIND OFF 5 sts in pattern, seed to end of row.

Seed 10 sts, reverse work and cable cast on 5 new sts, turn back to original side, connect to sts just cast on and seed to end of row.

Work in SEED STITCH for 60 more rows. THEN decrease as follows:

<i>P2tog, (k1, p1) x 11, k1</i>	<i>24 sts</i>
<i>(k1, p1) x 11, K2tog</i>	<i>23 sts</i>
<i>P2tog, (k1, p1) x 10, k1</i>	<i>22 sts</i>
<i>(k1, p1) x 10, K2tog</i>	<i>21 sts</i>
<i>P2tog, (k1, p1) x 9, k1</i>	<i>20 sts</i>
<i>(k1, p1) x 9, K2tog</i>	<i>19 sts</i>
<i>P2tog, (k1, p1) x 8, k1</i>	<i>18 sts</i>
<i>(k1, p1) x 8, K2</i>	<i>17 sts</i>
<i>P2tog, (k1, p1) x 7, k1</i>	<i>16 sts</i>
<i>(k1, p1) x 7, K2tog</i>	<i>15 sts</i>

Work seed stitch as established over the remaining 15 sts for about 40 more rows or until there is just enough yarn (20 inches) to bind off loosely in pattern. Weave in ends. Sew on your button. Wear and Enjoy! Xox mary ellen
